

USPAE Position: Executive Director

Overview

USPAE is seeking candidates for the position of Executive Director to lead the organization into a new period of growth. This position requires someone with an understanding of the electronics industry who has experience working in the government sector, preferably with the Department of Defense.

Responsibilities:

- Develop, implement, and lead a strategy that will best support the organization's mission as set by the board of directors.
- Establish and grow stakeholder relationships with industry, academia, and government that will support the organization's strategy.
- Communicate with stakeholders through all applicable public and private channels to strengthen the USPAE brand and position the organization as a valuable resource.

- Excellent communications skills, with a history of effectively interacting at all levels of government organizations.
- Established executive acumen in the areas of business operations, revenue generation, fiscal management, strategic vision, partnerships, decision-making, and driven results
- Residency in the Washington, DC region strongly preferred to facilitate frequent government interaction but flexible on working from home.
